The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (Public Law 116-136) includes funding to assist airports address the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The Federal Aviation Administration is offering an "e-Signature" process for all grant agreements executed in FY2020. While the e-Signature process is not required; airports are strongly encouraged to utilize this streamlined and expedited process for FY2020 grants and specifically funds authorized under the CARES Act. FAA cannot provide an estimated timeline of completion for applications transmitted using 'traditional' methods, such as mail or fax. The CARES Act does not require a match and by using the e-Signature process you will receive funds for operational expenses, such as payroll, utility bills, or payment of debt service much more quickly. If you choose to use all or a portion of your CARE Act funding for development projects please be sure to coordinate with your RO/ADO as there are prerequisites and additional requirements for construction projects, and as a result this grant will not be issued as quickly.
